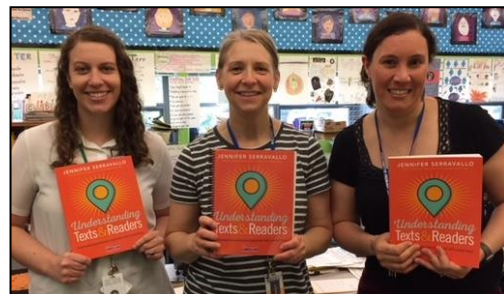

- **New Funding Formula:** \$100 for groups of 3-8 participants; \$150 for groups of 9+ participants
- One graduate credit is available from Western Oregon University: \$60 fee for credit + \$20 processing fee
- NEW! Requirements to Receive WOU Credit:
  - read a professional book
  - attend ten hours of discussion and complete a 3-page reflection paper
